The teams consist of Consultant Psychiatrists, Mental Health Social Workers, Community Psychiatric Nurses, Assessment Officers, Support Time and Recovery Workers, Occupational Therapists, Psychological Therapists and approved Mental Health Professionals.

The Acute Psychiatric in-patient facilities are now located within the Mental Health Unit on St Catherine's Hospital site. There is also a variety of support offered by locally and nationally based voluntary groups.
