Wheelchair Hire Service

DIAL continues to provide an affordable wheelchair hire service and has a new selection of lightweight manual wheelchairs which can be hired on a short-term basis. We now have heavy duty, bariatric wheelchairs available, which have a seat width of 24" and are designed for users up to 30 stone in weight. We can also provide adult leg extensions for people with full leg casts.

Our hire rates remain very competitive at only £4 per day, £8 per weekend (Friday to Monday) or £16 for a full week.



Shared Lives

Supporting people since 1994, The Avalon Group is an award-winning social care charity providing flexible person-centred care, support and companionship for everyday life, housing, employment, holidays and travel. Working with individuals, they create tailor-made support according to need and preferences. We asked them to tell us about the Shared Lives Scheme which allows carers to work from home, providing long term living solutions, short term placements, respite care or short breaks.



1. What is the Shared Lives Scheme?

Under the Avalon Group's Shared Lives Scheme, paid carers offer adults and young people with disabilities or a health condition a place to live in their home. It can also provide a support option to older people who can no longer remain in their own homes, but want to retain as much independence as possible within a caring family environment. Once approved, the carer can offer long term accommodation, short breaks and respite or day opportunities. Living as part of a Shared Lives Family enables individuals to develop their confidence and skills. The Avalon Group has delivered Shared Lives for over 20 years and is one of the largest independent providers of this innovative service in England.

2. Who is eligible to access the service?

Anyone from 16 years upwards with an identified need for care and support, Shared Lives enables the individuals to receive care and support within a family environment and be included in family life.

3. What support is provided?

Shared Lives carers provide a wide and varied range of support, including personal care, emotional support, daily living skills, support to access education, employment, leisure opportunities and take holidays. Customers are matched carefully with carers, with consideration given to home and lifestyle, individual personalities, shared interests and hobbies and the skill of the carer in relation to the identified needs of the customer.

4. How is someone's suitability identified?

Avalon carries out a needs assessment to identify what support is needed and if Shared Lives is the right option for the individual. We already provide Shared Lives services for many people with different needs seeking various levels of service. These include:

- → Individuals with physical disabilities
- → Young people in transition looking to move into independent living
- → Individuals with mental health needs
- ⊃ Older adults
- ⊃ People living with dementia

5. How do you apply?
